## **Botanic Gardens Trips**

We start the term with the Federation visits to the Cambridge University Botanic Gardens: Swallows, Eagles and Woodpecker Year 3 are going on Wednesday 8 June and Robins, Puffins, Kingfishers and Woodpeckers Year 2 are going on Friday 10 June.

On the days of the trips, for those children travelling, the gates at each school will be open from 7.50am.

They must be in school by 8am. The children will be in school uniform and will need sunhats, sun-cream, lunch, and refillable water bottles and raincoats. The weather can be so changeable.

Please make sure that the children are wearing comfortable, sturdy shoes as they will be on their feet and walking for a considerable time each day.

On Wednesday we expect to be back about 4.45pm and on Friday around 4pm.

#### **Healthy Snacks In School**

All children in EYFS and KS1 are offered a piece of fruit or vegetables every day as a healthy snack. This is funded by the government 'School Fruit and Vegetable Scheme'.

Following on from this, in KS2 we encourage our children to have a healthy snack during the morning break. This is a snack they bring in from home. It still needs to be fruit or vegetables.

Examples of what would be suitable are: fruit or vegetables either whole, cut up, fresh or dried, but not processed foods such as Fruit Winders. We would suggest dried fruit only once a week, and we also ask that grapes are not sent in as they can be a choking hazard.

Fresh water is available all day, and the children are offered milk to drink once a day too.

#### Keeping Safe In The Sun

The hot weather is now with us, even though intermittently.

The children need to have sunhats in school every day now please.

We will encourage the children to drink water throughout the day too.

## **Sports Days**

We would like to invite families to come and support the children at our School Sports Days – always very exciting events!

Due to the growing numbers of children in both Federation schools, it has been decided to change the arrangements for Sports Days this year. These changes will allow the children in all year groups to support and cheer on siblings and other teammates from across the different Key Stages in their own school. The tea parties at the end of last term illustrated so clearly how the children love to be together on these special days.

We also hope it will help the many parents who have children in both Key Stages. Parents will only need to arrange for one afternoon away from work, or other commitments, to be able to support all their own children. Hopefully, the afternoons will be super, fun, family and community events!
