

Dear Parents

Please see below the information for our online learning during lockdown. All our learning is linked to our long-term rolling programme as far as we possibly can. There will be differences across our federation because of the make-up of our class structures being slightly different.

Reception and Year 1 children will have 3 days of pre-recorded Phonics and Maths sessions followed by an afternoon online live session with a teacher. On Thursday and Friday, they will have a link to Oak Academy Maths, Geography/KUW, Science and RE.

Year 2 to Year 6 will have pre-recorded English and Maths 4 days per week. On those days they will also have an afternoon online live session with a teacher to support any issues from the lessons that day. On the 5th day we are providing links to Oak Academy Science, Geography and RE that link to our units of work. The children should only do one lesson per week per subject from the links.

Please see below your child's timetable. Key worker children in school will be following this time table too. Should you have problems accessing TEAMS or Oak Academy Mrs Barmby and I will be looking at the BBC resources next week as another option.

The links to the relevant units of work for Science, Geography and RE are pasted below.

Your child's teacher for online sessions will be Mrs Coupland and the additional adult will be Mrs Millard. Mrs Coupland is the class teacher from Robins at Gedney Hill. Mrs Barmby and I will also be joining some of the sessions.
