Sight

Your eyes let you see what is around you. Sometimes people need glasses to make their sight clearer.



Hearing

Your ears let you hear what is going on around you. We can hear soft, quiet sounds and heavy, loud noises.

Touch

Your skin gives you the sense of touch. It tells you if things are soft and warm or smooth and cold.

Taste
