Welcome back to our new term. We have lots of updates for you.

Phonics & Early Reading

We are very pleased to say that the changes we have made to our phonics & reading scheme are having a really positive impact on progress across the school. Mrs Barmby and I are working hard to have our library projects complete by Christmas.

Class Structure and Staffing

We have made some changes to the class structure at Gedney Hill due to an increase in numbers over the last half term. Mr Dullaghan has joined us in Year 5/6 whilst we advertise for a permanent member of staff at Gedney Hill, and Mrs Cropley now teaches Y4; the class will continue to be called Swallows as a whole: Swallows Y4 and Swallows 5/6.
